

# Levitra side effects



People are not the same. What one person may eat or drink without effect, may cause another to be violently ill. Although the testing and regulation system for medicines declares new products to be “safe”, this does not mean that everyone can take them without risk of adverse side-effects. There will always be a very small number who do have problems. The same thing is with **Levitra**. As a preventative measure, tell your doctor if you have allergies. These may indicate the possibility of an allergic

reaction to this medicine. You should also avoid drinking more than a token amount of alcohol when taking this medication and, in the long term, giving up smoking will reduce the risk of erectile dysfunction. Always take the dosage prescribed and do not increase the dosage without a doctor’s approval.

One of **Levitra side-effects** of low blood pressure is that less fluid goes through your optic nerves. In a very small number of cases, men report a slight change to their vision. This may first show up as a change in your ability to see colours or a loss of peripheral vision. In exceptionally rare cases, it can slowly involve a temporary loss of vision. Should this seem to be happening, go to a hospital immediately. You should also take emergency action if you experience priapism, i.e. a painful erection that lasts a long time, or symptoms suggesting a violent allergic reaction, a stroke or a heart attack.



Because there is a risk of your blood pressure dropping the first time you take this medication, do not drive or use dangerous equipment until you know how your body will react. Stand up or get out of bed slowly. The symptoms of drowsiness, dizziness and, potentially, fainting are more common if the weather is hot, you have been exercising, e.g. as in playing a sport, not simply having sex, or you are running a temperature. Be careful.

There are other possible side-effects but, for the most part, they are mild and pass quickly. You can afford to ignore these symptoms unless they grow more severe. Finally, do not believe *Levitra* has magic properties. If you have unprotected sex, you can catch a sexually transmitted disease or find your partner pregnant. Levitra is not a condom.
